ELIBILITY

Medicare beneficiaries can receive home health care benefits when they meet the following criteria.

- Because of illness or injury, you require assistance such as supportive devices, special transportation, or help from another person in order to leave the home OR you have a condition which leaving home is medically contraindicated.

- You have a normal inability to leave home.
- A considerable and taxing effort is necessary when you leave home.

The home health agency caring for you must be approved by the Medicare program.

Homebound eligibility is not affected by regular absences from the home when the reason for leaving is to receive certain types of medical care. CMS allows absences from home to participate "in therapeutic, psychosocial or medical treatment in an adult daycare program that is licensed or certified by a state." Other allowable absences for health care treatment include those for dialysis, chemotherapy or radiation therapy.

Other short and infrequent absences from home also are allowed, including attending religious service, visiting the barber, or attending a unique event such as a family reunion, funeral or graduation.
